

Skills Intensive Program, "Modern Man" Segment

This is the first segment of a four year progressive education program that is designed to teach students ages 9 and up basic outdoor skills, responsible use of and respect for the environment, teamwork, and mental and physical emergency preparedness. This eight week program includes instruction on mental preparedness, making fire, finding or building a proper shelter, potable water, wild edibles, useful knots and cordage, first aid, emergency skills, and a practical exercise. It includes meals, materials, and a graduation dinner. At the end of the program, students will have basic knowledge of the skills outlined above, and a basic preparedness pack which includes a manual and over \$100.00 worth of preparedness items. (materials for fire making, water purification, and signaling, notepad and pen, space blanket, a first aid kit, cordage, basic food items and more.)
