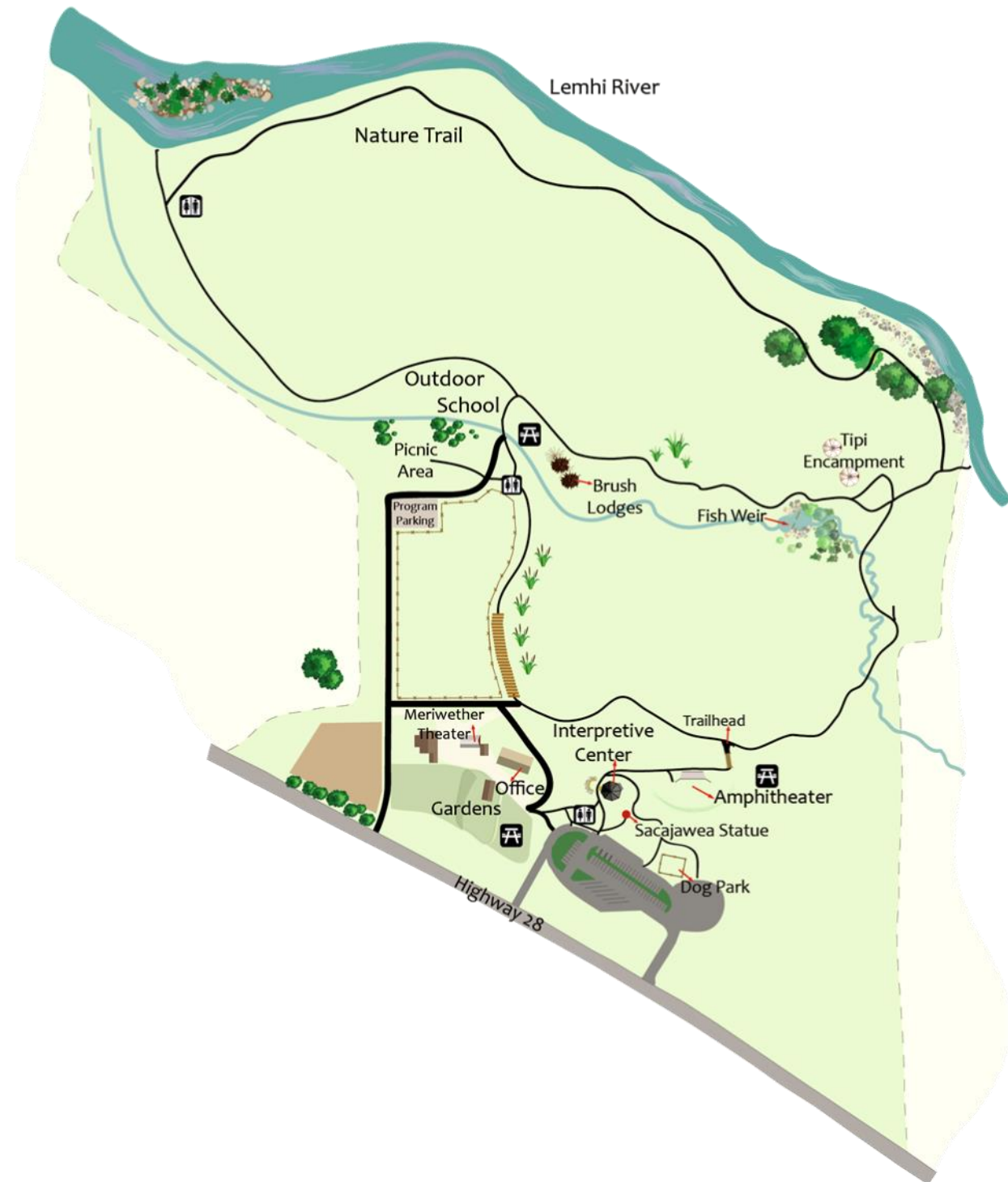

2020 marks the 20 year anniversary of the Sacajawea dollar and the 100th anniversary of the ratification of the 19th amendment.

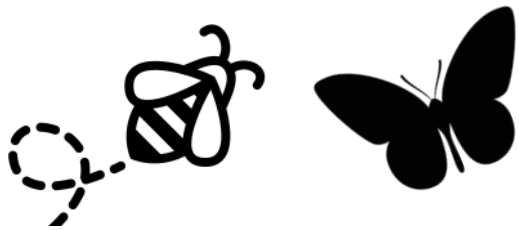
June history month will have a special focus on women in Lemhi County and their stories and important places in Lemhi County and American history.
